AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED OCTOBER 1, 2025 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2028 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME) REPRESENTING APPROXIMATELY 1,800 MEMBERS, INCLUDING PARTTIME EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Approved. That certain proposed October 1, 2025 - September 30, 2028 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) (the "Agreement"), a copy of which has been placed On File with Legislative Services Division, is hereby approved. AFSCME represents approximately 1,800 members, including part-time employees. The Agreement has been agreed to in collective bargaining and has been ratified by the union membership.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance and all elements of the AFSCME Collective Bargaining Agreement shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
