WHEREAS, Section 86.103(a), Ordinance Code, outlines the composition of the Commission which shall consist of seven voting members from the general public, three of whom are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council and four of whom shall be appointed by the Council President and confirmed by Council who, to the extent possible, shall possess specialized knowledge about the needs of the homeless and chronic unhoused populations; now therefore
