7 A RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MOURNING
8 THE PASSING OF JOAN TURNER; PROVIDING AN
9 EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 **WHEREAS**, Joan Turner was the wife of Aaron Turner for more
12 than fifty years; she was a mother, a grandmother and a great-
13 grandmother. She was a graduate of the University of North Florida,
14 and Dowling College in Oakdale, New York and the O.M. Kelly
15 Seminary and Training Institute in New York City, New York. Joan
16 Turner; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Joan Turner was a treasured public servant who worked
18 for the City of Jacksonville for more than two decades, and a
19 volunteer who donated countless hours of her time to helping
20 others. Mrs. Turner earned the honor of numerous awards over the
21 years, including the L.I. Alexander Community Services Award from
22 the Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce-Northwest Council; the NAACP
23 Sallye B. Mathis Community Services Award; the Community Service
24 Award for Northeast Florida for giving of her services to the
25 Community by Onyx Magazine; the Team Leadership Award by the City
26 of Jacksonville; Outstanding Leadership and Community Service Award
27 by the Senior Life Foundation, Inc.; and commendations from the
28 Jacksonville City Council; and

29 **WHEREAS**, Joan Turner was a tireless advocate for
30 Jacksonville's senior community, and worked especially hard to
31 provide social and financial support for the low-income aging-

1 population. Mrs. Turner also gave her time to serving on several
2 organizations, such as the Florida Council on Aging and the Senior
3 Life Foundation in Jacksonville; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Joan Turner was a woman of strong Christian faith, an
5 Angel of Mercy and was widely admired for her compassion and
6 dedication to community outreach. Mrs. Turner served as the leader
7 of the Senior Ministry for the Open Arms Christian Fellowship, and
8 she was an inspirational role model in the community; now therefore

9 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

10 **Section 1.** The City of Jacksonville hereby honors Joan
11 Turner for a lifetime of faithful service to our community and
12 mourns her passing. City Council extends condolences to her family,
13 friends and to all who were fortunate to have known her.

14 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
