A RESOLUTION HONORING ROLAND "LIL DUVAL" POWELL FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO ENTERTAINMENT AND CULTURE, AND DECLARING JUNE 12, 2025, AS "LIL DUVAL DAY" IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, IN RECOGNITION OF HIS WORK AS A HOMETOWN HERO WHO HAS ELEVATED THE PROFILE OF DUVAL COUNTY THROUGH COMEDY, MUSIC, AND COMMUNITY CAMARADERIE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Roland Powell, professionally known as "Lil Duval," is a nationally recognized comedian, actor, and musician who proudly hails from Jacksonville, Florida, and whose stage name is a direct tribute to his home county of Duval; and

WHEREAS, after graduating from First Coast High School, Powell pursued his passion for entertainment, rising through the ranks of Atlanta's comedy scene to earn national acclaim, all while consistently and publicly representing Jacksonville with pride; and

WHEREAS, Powell's break came in 2005 as a finalist on BET's Coming to the Stage, and he later became a regular on MTV2's Guy Code, Hip Hop Squares, and Ain't That America, while continuing to perform across the country and bring laughter to millions; and

WHEREAS, his 2018 hit single "Smile (Living My Best Life)" featuring Snoop Dogg and Ball Greezy became an anthem for positivity, joy, and authenticity, peaking at number 56 on the Billboard Hot 100, further proving his influence in both music and comedy; and

WHEREAS, Powell has appeared in music videos alongside

Southern hip hop royalty including T.I., Yung Joc, Wale, and Three 6 Mafia, and his original routines such as the "Stalker's Anthem" have become cult classics in the comedy world; and

WHEREAS, through his success, Powell has never wavered in his commitment to his hometown, continuously shouting out Duval County in his work and personal branding, using his platform to uplift, entertain, and remind the world where he's from; and

WHEREAS, the inaugural Duval Day Concert, featuring major national artists and curated by Powell, further reinforces his dedication to fostering cultural vibrancy, economic opportunity, and local pride in Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and appropriate for the City of Jacksonville to formally recognize Roland "Lil Duval" Powell's achievements and celebrate his contributions to culture, comedy, and community with a dedicated day of honor; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Roland "Lil Duval" Powell for his outstanding accomplishments in entertainment and his unwavering commitment to Duval County and the City of Jacksonville. The City Council hereby declares June 12, 2025, as "Lil Duval Day" in the City of Jacksonville, Florida, encouraging all residents to celebrate hometown pride, community unity, and cultural excellence.
