WHEREAS, the Achieving the Dream Scholarship Program was created in 1998 by Tomas Jiménez, founding Chair of the Mayor's Hispanic American Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Achieving the Dream Scholarship Program benefits eligible students of Hispanic and Latino heritage pursuing higher education and who demonstrate financial need. Students demonstrate eligibility with residency in Duval, Baker, St. Johns, Clay, or Nassau Counties and citizenship, minimum grade point average of 3.0, writing skills, letters of recommendation, and personal interviews. Selected students are awarded scholarships at the annual Achieving the Dream Scholarship Award Gala event each October; and

WHEREAS, the Achieving the Dream Scholarship Program awards between \$25,000 and \$40,000 to eligible Hispanic American students each year, and has awarded over \$600,000 in the last two decades to Hispanic American students in First Coast counties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Hispanic American Advisory Board and the First Coast Hispanic Chamber of Commerce together celebrate the Achieving the Dream Scholarship Program; now therefore
