This school was not listed as a possible site in the new RFP issued in March 2020 as, at the time of release, Duval County Public Schools (DCPS) intended on closing the school for the 20-21 school year. Since that time, DCPS decided not to close the school and they would like students to still have access to these services. In an effort to continue to serve students at this school for the additional year DCPS plans to keep it open, KHA requests permission to direct fund the provider (CIS) who has already been working with them.					
This provider is in good standing with KHA and has provided quality services to children at Carter G. Woodson and numerous other school sites.
