For special Council or Council committee meetings set for times prior to 5:00 p.m., the statement must be received by 2:00 p.m. the prior business day. So for example, if individuals want to submit comments to committee meetings, they would use the same email address for Council meetings and submit their comments for Monday committee meetings by 2:00 p.m. the Friday prior to committee meeting occurring on Monday or for Tuesday committee meetings, 2:00 p.m. the Monday prior to the Tuesday committee meetings.
