Bill Summary: This bill confirms the mayor's appointment of Kevin Craig to the Downtown Development Review Board, as a full-time employee at a business or professional office located within the downtown area representative, replacing Gary Monahan, for a first full term to expire on June 30, 2026.

Background Information: The Downtown Development Review Board is established pursuant to Section 656.361.9, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to review and make decisions with respect to all applications for development and redevelopment within the Downtown Overlay Zone.

The nine voting members of the board are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, in various categories including three downtown property owners or owners of or full-time employees at a business or professional office located within the downtown area.

Mr. Craig holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Central Florida. He is the Regional Director of Corporate External and Legislative Affairs for AT&T.
