6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,500,000.00 FROM
7 THE NORTHBANK RIVERWALK - NORTHBANK BULKHEAD
8 PROJECT TO THE SOUTHBANK BULKHEAD PROJECT (THE
9 "PROJECT") TO PAY FOR INCREASED CONSTRUCTION
10 COSTS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-041; AMENDING THE
11 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN
12 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO TRANSFER
13 FUNDING TO THE SOUTHBANK BULKHEAD PROJECT;
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
20 listed in subsection (b):

22 by this reference)

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

28 The funding above represents an appropriation of
29 \$2,500,000.00 from the Northbank Riverwalk - Northbank
30 Bulkhead project to the Southbank Bulkhead project (the
31 "Project") to provide additional funding to cover increased

1 costs of the Project due to unforeseen cost escalations.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Northbank
4 Riverwalk - Northbank Bulkhead project to the Project to provide
5 additional funding for the Project. This appropriation is necessary
6 to cover unforeseen cost escalations. This transfer is possible
7 because a grant was received to fund the Northbank
8 Riverwalk - Northbank Bulkhead project.

9 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
10 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
11 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
12 hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project,
13 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached
14 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The
15 City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP
16 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to
17 the best interests of the community because such deferral will
18 unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

19 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
20 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
21 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
22 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
23 an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the
24 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E
25 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

26 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
