Goodwill Industries is partnering to operate both the Grocery Store and the job training/education space.						
The overall project cost is expected to be over \$2.3 million. Of the overall cost \$1.6 million of construction and furnishings will be made for the grocery store component. The proposed legislation will provide a grant amount of \$650,000. This is 40 percent of the cost to develop the neighborhood grocery store.
