Type of Action: Approve and authorize the mayor to execute and deliver a Twelfth Amendment to the Amended and Restated Equestrian Center Services Contract; provide for oversight

Bill Summary: This bill approves and authorizes the mayor to execute and deliver a Twelfth Amendment to the Amended and Restated Equestrian Center Services Contract between the City and Northeast Florida Equestrian Society/H.O.R.S.E. Therapies, Inc., to effectuate the intent of this ordinance. It also provides for oversight by the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department.

Background Information: The Twelfth Amendment revises and updates the insurance and indemnification requirements as requested and approved by the Risk Management Division. It may include such additions, deletions, and changes as may be reasonable, necessary, and incidental for carrying out those purposes. No modifications may increase the financial obligations of the City or decrease the duties and obligations of Northeast Florida Equestrian Society. Any such modifications shall be technical only, meaning that they shall have no financial impact on the city, and shall include any other non-substantive changes that do not increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Amended and Restated Equestrian Center Services Contract. The Amendment may be retroactively dated to August 25, 2025, to maintain continuity with the insurance that Northeast Florida Equestrian Society currently carries.
