25-487	Amendment	(ORD Adopting a Small-Scale Amendmnt to the FLUM Series of the 2045 Comp Plan at
		11153 Beach Blvd, btwn Desalvo Rd & Cortez Rd - (2.29± Acres) – CGC & LDR to LI on
		0.91 of an Acre, & LDR to CGC on 1.38 Acres, for a Total of 2.29± Acres - My Jax, LLC):
		1. Remove the CGC to LI component
		2. Change the LDR to LI request to a LDR to CGC request.

		1. Corrects an R.E. number listed in the bill.
25-781	Substitute	(ORD Making Certain Findings & Approp \$15,000,000 from Council Contingency Accts to Subsidies & Contributions to Private Org Accts (\$4,000,000) & Subsidies & Contributions to Other Govt Accts (\$11,000,000) to Prov City Funding for Various Progs & Capital Projs as Follows: (1) \$1,000,000 to Northeast Florida Builders Association, Inc. (NEFBA) for the NEFBA Workforce Dev Ctr, (2) \$2,675,000 to Edward Waters University, Inc. (EWU) for the Living, Learning, Community Ctr, (3) \$325,000 to Workforce Industrial Training, LLC (WIT) for the Operation Boost Initiative, (4) \$6,000,000 to the UNF for Capital Repairs & Upgrades to Hodges Stadium & Construction of Add'l Grass Practice Fields at the Facility, & (5) \$5,000,000 to FSCJ for Purchase of a Bldg at Cecil Commerce Ctr to House the FSCJ Training Institute; Auth the Mayor, or Her Desig, & the Corp Sec to Execute & Deliver Agrmts btwn the City & NEFBA, EWU, WIT, UNF, & FSCJ for the Respective Prog or
		Proj to Be Undertaken by Each Entity as More Particularly Described Herein; Waiving Sec 118.107 (Nonprofits to Receive Funding Through a Competitive Evaluated Award Process; Waiver & Disclosures), Pt 1 (General Provisions), Ch 118 (City Grants), Ord Code, to Allow for Direct Contracts with NEFBA & EWU):  Rules Substitute:
		1. Include oversight departments in the bill and Term Sheets.
		2. Revise the appropriation to include \$12 million from the General Fund - Special Council
		Reserve Contingency account and \$3 million from the Tourist Development Council fund
		balance.
		3. Reduce the appropriation for EWU by \$675,000 and place in a contingency for
		apprenticeship programs.
		4. Place remaining \$2 million for EWU in a contingency pending legal review of public
		purpose.
		5. Attach Third Revised Exhibit 1 (BT) to reflect the revised appropriation and correct
		account information.
		6. Authorize carryover of funding for EWU and UNF.
		7. Attach Second Revised Exhibit 3 (EWU Term Sheet) to:
		a. Include a deadline to complete the project (9/30/28 per EWU).
		b. Clarify audit rights apply to the entire project.

- c. Require that EWU provide support showing evidence of project financing prior to commencement.
  - d. Strike reference to FY 26/27 funding.
- e. Clarify that the City's proportionate share is no more than 37.5% for design, planning and permitting.
- f. Clarify that City funds will be disbursed on a reimbursement basis with appropriate documentation submitted prior.
  - g. Reflect revised maximum indebtedness of \$2 million.
- 8. Attach Revised Exhibit 4 (WIT Term Sheet) to clarify City funds will only reimburse training for Duval County residents.
- 9. Attach Revised Exhibit 5 (UNF Term Sheet) to:
  - a. Include a deadline to complete the project (9/30/27 per UNF).
  - b. Clarify audit rights apply to the entire project.
  - c. Add that reimbursements will be on a prorata basis (City funds 50%, UNF funds 50%).
- d. Add that UNF shall provide support showing they have their \$6 million available to begin the project.
- 10. Attach Revised Exhibit 6 (FSCJ Term Sheet) to:
- a. Add language that the purchase price cannot exceed the value identified by an appraisal.
- b. Extend the Recoupment Period to include 10 years from when the Training Institute begins operations, but no later than 1/1/29.

## Finance Second Substitute:

Rules Substitute, subject to the following changes:

- 1. Attach Fourth Revised Exhibit 1 (BT) to bring the \$2 million for EWU above the line.
- 2. Attach Second Revised Exhibit 2 (NEFBA Term Sheet) to:
  - a. Provide a more detailed Scope of Work.
  - b. Clarify frequency and requirements for documents to be submitted with draw requests.
- c. Clarify minimum workforce development training requirements and operations to be housed in the facility.
- d. Provide that the City and NEFBA shall enter into a Use Agreement detailing the City's rights for use of the facility.
- e. Provide that NEFBA shall provide a report at the end of the project reflecting the use of City certified JSEBs for the project in the aggregate amount of \$200,000 (20% of the City funding).
- 3. Attach Third Revised Exhibit 3 (EWU Term Sheet) to:
  - a. Provide that the City funds will be paid on a work performed and invoiced basis.
  - b. Clarify the services to be housed in the Living, Learning Community Center.
- c. Provide that the City and EWU shall enter into a Use Agreement detailing the City's rights for use of the facility.
- d. Provide that EWU shall use good faith efforts to enter into contracts with City certified JSEBs for the project in the aggregate amount of \$500,000 (20% of the City funding).
- 4. Include a waiver of Sections 110.112 and 118.201(f)(7) of the Code to allow for a 25% advance payment (\$81,250) to WIT.
- 5. Attach Second Revised Exhibit 4 (WIT Term Sheet) to:
  - a. Provide for a 25% advance of City funds (\$81,250) for the Program.
- b. Provide additional Program requirements including number of trainees/cohorts per month, requirements for successful completion of the Program, information on assessment of participant performance, etc.
  - c. Provide that the grant shall be subject to Chapter 118, Parts 1-5.
- 6. Attach Second Revised Exhibit 5 (UNF Term Sheet) to:
  - a. Provide a minimum scope of work for the project.

		b. Provide that the City and UNF shall enter into a Use Agreement detailing the City's
		rights for use of the facility.
		c. Provide that UNF shall use good faith efforts to contract with City certified JSEBs to
		provide materials or services in the aggregate amount of \$1,200,000 (20% of City funding).
		7. Attach Second Revised Exhibit 6 (FSCJ Term Sheet) to:
		a. Further describe the Training Institute and programs to be offered.
		b. Provide that the City funds shall disburse the City funds to an escrow agent selected by
		the City at least 3 days prior to the closing date for purchase of the building.
		c. Provide that the City and FSCJ shall enter into a Use Agreement detailing the City's
		rights for use of the facility.
