ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$802,300.54 ΑN ΙN FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FROM PERMANENT AND PROBATIONARY SALARIES AND ASSOCIATED FRINGE BENEFITS TO PENSION COSTS (\$22,175.54) TO FUND THE PENSION COSTS OF A GRANT-FUNDED POSITION AND TO CONTRACTUAL SERVICES (\$780,125.00) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FROM FAMILY FOUNDATIONS OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. PROVIDE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION SERVICES TO HIGH RISK PARTICIPANTS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-048; AUTHORIZING POSITION, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 24-075; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(E) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FAMILY FOUNDATIONS OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC.; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents a transfer in the amount of \$802,300.54 in federal grant funds from permanent and probationary salaries and associated fringe benefits to pension costs (\$22,175.54) to pay for the pension costs of a grant-funded position and to contractual services (\$780,125.00) to contract with Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. to provide intervention and prevention services to high risk participants. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer funds within the Mayor's Violence Reduction Center Accounts for contractual services and pension contribution. This funding will also support one (1) position within the Grants and Contracts Compliance Division.

Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby approved the position more fully described in R.C. 24-075, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(e),

Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure

the professional services of Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. pursuant to Section 126.107(e) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. Such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are prevention services related to mental health. Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. operates a not-for-profit corporation and has demonstrated the ability to provide high-quality, cost-efficient services in a timely manner.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with Family Foundations of Northeast Floria, Inc., in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,348,456.00 of which \$780,125.00 is being funded by this Ordinance and \$568,331.00 from a previous appropriation by Ordinance 2023-188-E, in substantially the same form as attached as Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Contract, April 1, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 6. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 7. Oversight. The Division of Grants and Contract Compliance of the Department of Finance and Administration shall oversee the Grant Agreement described herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
