Bill Summary: The bill appropriates a total of \$1,696,404.03 from the Drainage System Rehabilitation fund and the DSR General Capital Projects fund to supplement the funding for 6 drainage improvement projects currently under construction. It amends the 2023-27 Capital Improvement Plan to reflect the allocation of funding from the countywide funds to specific project accounts and increase the total cost for those projects.

Background Information: The projects to receive supplemental funding are: 1) Woolery Drive Drainage Study and Improvements project (\$720,660.70 – Council District 1); 2) Emerald Trail – S-Line to Stonewall Street construction (\$171,743.33 – District 7); 3) Harlow Boulevard/Mother Hubbard Drive South drainage restoration project (\$192,000 – District 9); 4) Ingleside Avenue drainage improvement (\$75,000 – District 7); 5) Irving Scott Drive curb inlets, drainage pipe and outfall (\$242,000 – District 10); and 6) Ortega Boulevard at Chippewa Drive drainage improvements project (\$295,000 – District 7). The transferred funds will supplement the project budgets to ensure completion of the projects.

Policy Impact Area: Drainage improvements

Fiscal Impact: The bill appropriates a total of \$1,696,404.03 from countywide drainage funds to specific project accounts.
