**Bill Summary:** This bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Erica L. Moore to the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission (JHCDC), as a general resident, for a second term ending November 30, 2026.

**Background Information:** The JHCDC is established pursuant to Chapter 34, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to provide oversight and guidance to the Housing and Community Development Division; make recommendations on all agreements entered into by the Housing and Community Development Division through the Neighborhoods Department for and on behalf of the City; conduct any required public hearings, undertake the review, take any and all required actions for compliance, and make recommendations to the Council for adoption (and authorize the transmittal) as required by section 420.9076, *Florida Statutes*; and conduct any required public hearings, undertake the review, take any and all required actions for compliance, and recommend to the Council for adoption (and authorize the transmittal) a "Consolidated Plan" as required by 24 CFR Part 91.

Section 34.203, *Ordinance Code*, provides that six of the members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council, representing various categories related to affordable housing.

Ms. Moore is currently Vice President of Social Responsibility & Operations at YMCA of Florida's First Coast. She has a Bachelor of Arts in Education from the University of North Florida. Ms. Moore resides within Council District 5.

Attendance: Ms. Moore attended 25 of 29 (86%) meetings in her first term.
