ΑN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ACCEPTANCE, PROCESSING, RECYCLING, AND/OR DISPOSAL OF RESIDENTIAL YARD TRASH GENERATED IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A SERVICE AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 386 (WASTE FLOW CONTROL), ORDINANCE CODE ("SERVICE AGREEMENT"), BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND GASTON TREE DEBRIS RECYCLING, L.L.C. ("GASTON LLC"), A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, TO ACCEPT, PROCESS, RECYCLE, AND/or DISPOSE OF RESIDENTIAL YARD TRASH GENERATED IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AT THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY HOLDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY NO. 2012-293-E-R1 LOCATED AT 7405 PHILIPS HIGHWAY, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32256; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, ADDITIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENTS AS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE BETWEEN THE CITY AND OWNERS/OPERATORS/CONTRACTORS SELECTED BY THE CITY, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 126 (PURCHASING CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, FOR THE ACCEPTANCE, PROCESSING, RECYCLING, AND/OR DISPOSAL OF RESIDENTIAL YARD TRASH GENERATED IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; AMENDING SECTION 380.303 (RATES FOR DISPOSAL),

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Agreement Approved and Execution Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, a service agreement pursuant to Chapter 386 (Waste Flow Control), Ordinance Code, between the City

of Jacksonville (the "City") and Gaston Tree Debris Recycling, L.L.C. ("Gaston LLC"), a Florida limited liability company, to accept, process, recycle, and/or dispose of residential yard trash generated in the City of Jacksonville at the solid waste management facility holding Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2012-293-E-R1 and located at 7405 Philips Highway, Jacksonville, Florida 32256. The service agreement shall include the scope of work and terms described on Exhibit 1 attached hereto ("Terms"), and shall be subject to all applicable local, state and federal rules and regulations, including but not limited to, Chapters 380 and 386, Ordinance Code, unless otherwise waived herein. Additionally, the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and deliver any and all other documents necessary to complete the transaction contemplated in this Section 1.

Additional authorization approved. Section 2. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, additional service agreements as City necessary and appropriate between the and owners/operators/contractors selected by the City pursuant to Chapter 126 (Purchasing Code), Ordinance Code, for the acceptance, processing, recycling, and/or disposal of residential yard trash generated in the City of Jacksonville. Such service agreements shall at a minimum meet the following condition: (1) City fees paid to an owner/operator/contractor to accept, process, recycle, and dispose of residential yard trash shall not exceed \$95.00 per ton; and (2) all applicable local, state and federal rules and regulations, including, but not limited to, Chapters 380 and 386, Ordinance Code unless otherwise waived herein, shall be incorporated into the agreement terms. Additionally, the Mayor, or his designee, Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute,

Section 4. Waiving provisions of Part 1 (Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity), Chapter 380 (Solid Waste Management), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Part 1 (Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity), Chapter 380 (Solid Waste Management), Ordinance Code, requiring a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is hereby waived as to City owned and operated facilities and/or owners/operators/contractors contracted by the City to accept process, recycle, and/or dispose of residential yard trash in the City of Jacksonville pursuant to the authority granted in Section 2 of this Ordinance. The waiver is necessary to City's ability to expedite the use City personnel owners/operators/contractors contracted by the City to accept, process, recycle, and/or dispose of residential yard trash in the City of Jacksonville by relieving the requirements to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

Upon the sunset and repeal of this Ordinance at the expiration of a one hundred and eighty day (180) period, the following amended Sections of the Code shall immediately be adopted and become effective with no further action by the Council and as amended shall read as follows:

section 8. Rule 4.901 Requesting Emergency Passage. Emergency passage of this legislation is requested upon introduction. The nature of the emergency is that currently the City's municipal residential haulers are unable to collect yard trash due to a shortage in labor and personnel. The collection of residential yard trash is an essential governmental service and the unforeseen economic environment has created circumstances that require an immediate response to return yard trash collections to its regular established schedule.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
