This agreement replaces a 25-year agreement between the City of Jacksonville and City of Atlantic Beach which ends on 5/31/24. The new agreement is effective June 1, 2024, and will continue for 2 years unless terminated earlier. It is the intent of the Agreement to provide an effective, efficient means of delivering Advanced Life Support Fire and Rescue Services to Atlantic Beach residents and businesses. The City of Jacksonville and Atlantic Beach residents can benefit from the services offered by the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department.
