5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,306,047.00 FROM  
6 MOTOR POOL FUND AND GENERAL FUND OPERATING  
7 FUND BALANCE TO FLEET MANAGEMENT - PARTS AND  
8 FUELING SERVICE TO OFFSET THE SHORTFALL IN THE  
9 FUEL BUDGET ARISING FROM A SIGNIFICANT  
10 INCREASE IN FUEL PRICES DURING FISCAL YEAR  
11 2021-2022, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-099;  
12 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;  
13 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
17 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
18 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
19 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

26 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation:**

27 The funding above is an appropriation of Motor Pool Fund  
28 and General Fund Operating fund balance to Fleet  
29 Management - Parts and Fueling Service to offset the  
30 budget shortfall in the fuel budget created by a  
31 significant increase in fuel costs in fiscal year 2021-

1                   2022.

2           **Section 2.           Purpose.**   The purpose of the appropriation in  
3 Section 1 is to offset the budget shortfall for fuel purchases for  
4 the remainder of fiscal year 2021-2022 arising from a significant  
5 increase in fuel costs over the past year.

6           **Section 3.           Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage**  
7 **Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.**   One cycle emergency  
8 passage of this legislation is requested.   The nature of the  
9 emergency is that there has been an unexpected, drastic increase in  
10 fuel prices which created a shortfall in the fiscal year 2021-2022  
11 fuel budget.   There is an urgent need to appropriate these  
12 additional funds to cover fuel expenditures for the remainder of  
13 fiscal year.

14           **Section 4.           Effective Date.**   This Ordinance shall become  
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
16 without the Mayor's signature.
