ORDINANCE 2026-446-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING TEMPORARY AND PERMANENT CHANGES IN POLLING PLACE LOCATIONS, AND BOUNDARY CHANGES WITHIN VARIOUS PRECINCTS, TO BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, BEGINNING WITH THE 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD AUGUST 18, 2026, IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS REQUESTED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 352.101 AND 352.102, *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Polling Place Location Changes Approved. At the request of the Supervisor of Elections for Duval County, and pursuant to Section 352.102, *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as the governing body for Duval County, hereby approves a temporary change in polling place location for Precincts 208 and 604, and a permanent change in polling place location for Precincts 105, 211, 307, 508, 811, 1104, 1105 and 1405, as outlined and attached hereto in **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev Notice, June 15, 2026 - NCSPHS" respectively, to be effective immediately. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to include these polling place locations in the Polling Place List on file in their respective offices.

Section 2. Precinct Boundary Changes Approved. At the request of the Supervisor of Elections for Duval County, and pursuant

1 to Section 352.101, *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as the
2 governing body for Duval County, hereby approves the boundary changes
3 with respect to the following Precincts: 1104, 1110, 1401, 1406 and
4 1408, as outlined and attached hereto in **Exhibit 2** respectively, to
5 be effective immediately. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council
6 Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to include these polling
7 place locations in the Polling Place List on file in their respective
8 offices.

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
