ORDINANCE 2025-870

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$53,490 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA - SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO OTHER GOVERNMENT ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE CITY GRANT FUNDING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA ("UNF") FOR THE UNF MILITARY AND VETERANS PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND UNF FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2025-2026 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$53,490 from General Fund Operating Reserves to the University of North Florida - Subsidies and Contributions to Other Government account, to provide a grant to University of North Florida ("UNF") for the UNF Military and Veterans Program (the "Program") as described herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to the University of North Florida for the UNF Military and Veterans Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is operated out of the UNF Military and Veterans Resource Center (the "MVRC") which serves over 2,000 military-connected students. In addition to helping these students certify and manage their veterans' educational benefits, the MVRC offers access to technology and equipment, free of charge, to assist students in their educational pursuits while also serving as a location for work study groups, completion of class projects, student collaborations, and development of presentations. The City grant dollars will be used to pay for certain capital improvements and equipment purchases for the MVRC and to support the Military Spouse Career Readiness Summit (the "Summit").

The Summit is a full-day event designed to equip military spouses in Duval County with the entrepreneurial tools, training, and resources needed to pursue business ownership as a viable and flexible career path. This event is tailored to the unique needs of military spouses and will offer both educational sessions and opportunities for participants to connect with local, state and federal resources that support business formation and growth. The City funds will offset various costs UNF will incur to host this event including venue and audio-visual equipment rental, marketing and outreach,

preparation/printing of materials and handouts, and professional service fees for two keynote speakers.

The remainder of the City funds will be used to purchase various equipment for the MVRC and to make improvements to the MVRC kitchen. Specifically, the funds will be used to purchase two interactive electronic whiteboards for installation in the main area and a private study room as well as equipment and appliances for the MVRC kitchen where military-connected students have access to free refreshments throughout the day. A portion of the City funds will also be used to purchase a golf cart to transport disabled and mobility-challenged veterans and military-connected students around the MVRC campus.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a grant agreement with University of North Florida in an amount not-to-exceed \$53,490, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on November 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
