8 ACCOUNT AND \$25,000.00 FROM THE DUVAL COUNTY TAX
9 COLLECTOR - COLLECTION FEES - ST. JOHNS RIVER
10 WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT ACCOUNT, TO THE TCSG
11 TAX COLLECTOR GENERAL OPERATIONS - FINANCIAL AND
12 ADMINISTRATION - POSTAGE ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE
13 FUNDING FOR INCREASED ANTICIPATED POSTAGE COSTS
14 FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026, AS
15 INITIATED BY B.T. 26-085; WAIVING THE PROVISIONS
16 OF SECTION 106.303 (FORMAT AND DETERMINATION OF
17 AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED), SUBPART A (GENERAL
18 PROVISIONS), PART 3 (APPROPRIATIONS), CHAPTER
19 106 (BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE), *ORDINANCE*
20 *CODE*, TO ALLOW MODIFICATION OF THE APPROPRIATION
21 OF FUNDS EXHIBIT TO FACILITATE COMPLIANCE WITH
22 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE AMERICANS WITH
23 DISABILITIES ACT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2025-2026 fiscal year,
27 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
28 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
29 listed in subsection (b):

5 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

6 The funding above represents an appropriation comprised of
7 \$90,000.00 from the Duval County Tax Collector - Tax
8 Collector Miscellaneous Revenue account and \$25,000.00
9 from the Duval County Tax Collector - Collection Fees -
10 St. Johns River Water Management District account to the
11 TCSG Tax Collector General Operations - Financial and
12 Administration - Postage account, to provide funding for
13 increased postage costs anticipated to be incurred in the
14 remainder of fiscal year 2025-2026.

15 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
16 Section 1 is to provide funding for increased postage costs
17 anticipated to be incurred in the 2025-2026 fiscal year in excess of
18 budgeted estimates. The funding is from collections received in excess
19 of budgeted estimates from various special districts for which the
20 Tax Collector retains a two percent commission for collecting and
21 distributing property tax revenue.

22 **Section 3. Waiving the Provisions of Section 106.303,**
23 **Ordinance Code.** Section 106.303 (Format and determination of amounts
24 appropriated), Subpart A (General Provisions), Part 3
25 (Appropriations), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), *Ordinance*
26 *Code*, is hereby waived. This waiver is necessary to allow the
27 modification of the Appropriation of Funds Exhibit to be in the form
28 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, in order to facilitate compliance with
29 the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. B.T. 26-085
30 in the form authorized pursuant to Ordinance 2015-428-E and reflecting
31 the Mayor's approval can be found on file with the Budget Office.

1 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
2 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
3 without the Mayor's signature.
