ORDINANCE 2025-646

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS
ORIGINALLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2024-160-E
TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, SO THE FUNDS REMAIN
AVAILABLE FOR THE HIRING OR RETENTION OF
LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL TO THE CITY COUNCIL PURSUANT
TO SECTION 7.01 OF THE CITY CHARTER AND CHAPTER
14 (OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL), *ORDINANCE
CODE*; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Carryover. The funds appropriated by Ordinance
2024-160-E for the hiring or retention of Legislative Counsel to the
City Council pursuant to Section 7.01 of the City Charter and Chapter
14 (Office of Legislative Counsel), *Ordinance Code*, shall not lapse
but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026 to remain available for
their original intended purpose. As of August 19, 2025, there is
\$77,953 remaining from the original appropriation amount of \$100,000
to be carried over pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
without the Mayor's signature.
