Type of Action: *Ordinance Code* amendment; provide for compliance with Section 121.104, *Ordinance Code*

Bill Summary: This bill amends Section 121.105 (Pensioner's Rights upon Reemployment by the City), Part 1 (Police and Fire Pension Fund Administration), Chapter 121 (Police and Firefighters Pension Plan), *Ordinance Code*. The bill also provides for compliance with Section 121.104 (Review of Proposed Legislation) of the *Ordinance Code*, which pertains to review and comment by the Police and Fire Pension Fund Board of Trustees, completion of an actuarial report, and a request for recommendations and comment from the State Division of Retirement.

Background Information: This amendment to Section 121.105, *Ordinance Code*, provides that sworn civil process server and Sheriff's liaison officer retirees shall be exempt from certain provisions pertaining to reemployment by adding those roles to subsection (d).

Policy Impact Area: Police and Fire Pension Plan
