8 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING VOTING PRECINCTS;
9 APPROVING THE REVISION AND CHANGES OF CERTAIN
10 VOTING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES IN THE CITY OF
11 JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN RESPONSE
12 TO LITIGATION BROUGHT AGAINST THE SUPERVISOR OF
13 ELECTIONS, AS REQUESTED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF
14 ELECTIONS PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 352.101 AND
15 352.102, *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING FOR COUNTY
16 PRECINCT MAPS AND POLLING PLACES ON FILE AND
17 ONLINE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Precinct Boundary Changes and Renumbering of**
21 **Precincts Approved; Authorizing and Directing Supervisor of Elections**
22 **and Council Secretary to Include Precinct Boundary Changes in the**
23 **Files in Their Respective Offices.** At the request of the Supervisor
24 of Elections for Duval County, as a result of a settlement of that
25 certain lawsuit styled Belinda Coenen, et al. v. Duval County
26 Supervisor of Elections, pending in the United States District Court,
27 Middle District of Florida, Case No. 3:23-cv-868-MMH-MCR, and
28 pursuant to Section 352.101, *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as
29 the governing body for Duval County, hereby approves the precinct
30 boundary changes and renumbering of precincts in the City of
31 Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, as reflected in the individual

1 Council District maps attached hereto as **Exhibit 1 (Precinct Boundary**
2 **Changes)**. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary are
3 hereby authorized and directed to include the Precinct Maps in their
4 files in their respective offices.

5 **Section 2. Polling Place Location Changes Approved;**
6 **Authorizing and Directing Supervisor of Elections and Council**
7 **Secretary to Include Polling Place Locations In the Files in Their**
8 **Respective Offices.** At the request of the Supervisor of Elections
9 for Duval County, as a result of a settlement of that certain lawsuit
10 styled Belinda Coenen, et al. v. Duval County Supervisor of Elections,
11 pending in the United States District Court, Middle District of
12 Florida, Case No. 3:23-cv-868-MMH-MCR, and pursuant to Section
13 352.102, *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as the governing body
14 for Duval County, hereby approves the polling place location changes
15 as listed in the attached **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised
16 Exhibit 2, Rev Location List, October 2, 2023 - NCSPHS" to be
17 effective immediately for all special, primary and general elections
18 conducted after passage. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council
19 Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to include these Polling
20 Place Locations in their files in their respective offices.

21 **Section 3. Precinct Boundary Map of Entire County in the**
22 **Files at Supervisor of Elections and Council Secretary Offices.** A
23 precinct boundary map of the entire county, a map of each new
24 precinct, and the locations of all polling place locations are in the
25 files of the Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary in
26 their respective offices. A written description of each precinct
27 boundary is in the Supervisor of Elections' file in his office.
