**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to reallocate funds previously appropriated to the Technology Solutions Department for development and administration of the JaxCode4Change program to the City Council Special Committee on Youth Empowerment for a future recommendation on appropriation of the funds to support the Special Committee's initiatives.
