**ORDINANCE 2025-110**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER TWO FIRST AMENDMENTS TO FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 CURE VIOLENCE SERVICES CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND THE POTTER'S HOUSE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EMPOWERING CENTER, INC. TO EXTEND THE TERM AND AMEND THE PROGRAM BUDGET DETAIL; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Jacksonville (the "City") and The Potter's House Community Development Empowering Center, Inc. ("Recipient"), previously entered into that certain Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Cure Violence Services Contract (Northside) dated October 1, 2023 ("Northside") and that certain Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Cure Violence Services Contract (Westside) dated October 1, 2023 ("Westside") (collectively, the "Contracts"), as authorized by Ordinance 2023-504-E, to provide funding from the City to Recipient in the amount of \$303,333.00 and \$309,166.00, respectively, (the "Maximum Indebtedness") to be used to implement the Cure Violence Public Health Violence Reduction Model to interrupt violent conflicts and eliminate violence; and

**WHEREAS,** Recipient has requested to amend the Contracts to adjust the program budget details in order to reallocate funding between certain line items of the budget without increasing the

1 Maximum Indebtedness and extend the term of the Contracts to allow  
2 the City to close out the contract and keep the Recipient off of the  
3 City's Non-Compliance List in accordance with the revised program  
4 budget detail; and

5 **WHEREAS,** the term of the Contracts expired on January 31, 2024,  
6 and Recipient has requested the City to enter into a First Amendment  
7 to Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Cure Violence Services Contract (Northside)  
8 in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, and a First  
9 Amendment to Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Cure Violence Service Contract  
10 (Westside) in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit**  
11 **2**, both of which being incorporated herein by this reference (the  
12 "Amendments") having an effective date of January 31, 2024 to revive  
13 the Contracts and maintain contractual continuity; now therefore

14 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute Amendment**  
16 **to Contract.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her  
17 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to  
18 execute and deliver the Amendments. The Amendments amend certain line  
19 items of the Budget/Fee Schedules and Complete Program Budget Details  
20 to reallocate funding to allow for unforeseen expenses and to correct  
21 a discrepancy, without increasing the Maximum Indebtedness, in order  
22 to stay off of the City's Non-Compliance List, and extend the term  
23 of the Contracts to allow the City to close out the Contracts, with  
24 all other terms and conditions of the Contracts remaining unchanged.

25 **Section 2. Oversight Department.** The Grants and Contract  
26 Compliance Division of the Finance and Administration Department  
27 shall continue to have oversight of the Contracts described herein.

28 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
29 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
30 without the Mayor's signature.
