6 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF
7 LINDA F. MCCALLUM, A FORMER CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE
8 AND DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE
9 JACKSONVILLE ETHICS COMMISSION, PURSUANT TO
10 SECTION 602.912, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A FIRST
11 FULL TERM TO EXPIRE DECEMBER 31, 2025; PROVIDING
12 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **WHEREAS**, Resolution 2021-569-A confirmed the appointment of
15 Linda F. McCallum to the Jacksonville Ethics Commission, for an
16 initial partial term to expire December 31, 2022; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Section 602.912(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that
18 initial terms on the Jacksonville Ethics Commission for less than two
19 years shall not be considered a full term for purposes of
20 reappointment; now therefore

21 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Reappointment Confirmation.** The Council hereby
23 confirms the Chief Judge’s reappointment of Linda F. McCallum, a
24 former Circuit Court judge and a Duval County resident, to the
25 Jacksonville Ethics Commission, pursuant to Section 602.912,
26 *Ordinance Code*, for a first full three-year term to expire December
27 31, 2025. Correspondence from the Chief Judge, Mark H. Mahon, is
28 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

29 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
30 effective upon signature of the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor’s signature.
