5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$175,591.52 IN
6 FUNDS AWARDED BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY
7 MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) THROUGH THE STATE OF
8 FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
9 (FDEM) FOR FLOOD MITIGATION GRANT - MITIGATION
10 RECONSTRUCTION OF REPETITIVE LOSS PROJECT (THE
11 "PROJECT") TO DEMOLISH ONE RESIDENTIAL
12 STRUCTURE AND CONSTRUCT A NEW ELEVATED
13 STRUCTURE ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 10253 SHARK
14 ROAD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32226, AS
15 AUTHORIZED BY B.T. 20-045; APPROVING AND
16 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND
17 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER
18 THE FEDERALLY-FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT
19 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND
20 FDEM AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO
21 RECEIVE THE GRANT FUNDS AND TO EFFECTUATE THE
22 PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE; APPROVING AND
23 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND
24 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER
25 THE FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT
26 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND
27 DEMMI JO MURPHY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
28 THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT'S
29 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS; PROVIDING
30 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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2 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

3 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
4 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
5 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
6 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

13 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

14 The funding above was awarded by the Federal Emergency
15 Management Agency (FEMA) through the State of Florida
16 Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) for Flood
17 Mitigation Grant - Mitigation Reconstruction of
18 Repetitive Loss Property (the "Project"). The total
19 estimated cost of the Project is \$208,635.42. The federal
20 grant provides approximately 84.16% of the funding for
21 the Project. The homeowner, Demmi Jo Murphy, must provide
22 a 10% match, such match being \$33,043.90, or 15.84% of
23 the total cost, a percentage resulting from the fact that
24 FEMA will only pay \$150,000.00 in "construction costs,"
25 with the homeowner being responsible for construction
26 costs in excess of \$150,000.00. The funding expires April
27 1, 2022.

28 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
29 Section 1 is to provide funding for a mitigation reconstruction of
30 one residential property located at 10253 Shark Road, Jacksonville,
31 Florida 32226. The City will demolish one residential structure and

1 construct a new elevated structure no more than 10% larger than the
2 original structure at least one foot above the Base Flood
3 Elevation.

4 **Section 3. Approving and authorizing Federally-Funded**
5 **Subaward and Grant Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the
6 Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby
7 authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City,
8 the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the City
9 and the Florida Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which
10 has been placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services,
11 and all other documents necessary to receive the grant funds
12 described herein and to effectuate the purpose of this ordinance.

13 **Section 4. Approving and authorizing Flood Mitigation**
14 **Assistance Grant Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the
15 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby
16 authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City,
17 the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Agreement between the City of
18 Jacksonville and Demmi Jo Murphy, a copy of which has been placed
19 **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

20 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Division of Emergency
21 Preparedness of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department shall
22 oversee the project described herein.

23 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
25 without the Mayor's signature.
