ORDINANCE 2025-379-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,070.15 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SEVEN (7) PERMANENT GENERATORS AT SEVEN (7) STORMWATER PUMP LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT DUVAL COUNTY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-089; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, MODIFICATION NUMBER TWO TO THE SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, CONTRACT NUMBER H0543; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION; AMENDING THE 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "STORMWATER PUMP STATIONS GENERATORS"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

9 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

10 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency
11 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation
12 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of
13 Emergency Management for the purchase and installation of
14 seven (7) permanent generators at seven (7) stormwater pump
15 stations in Duval County.

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
17 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation of
18 permanent generators to be located at seven stormwater pump stations
19 located in Duval County and more specifically at Hillman Drive
20 (Treetop Estates), Myrtle Avenue, Hilly Road (Trout River), Bradley
21 Road, Jessie Street, McGirts Creek Park (Lew Brantley), and Sandalwood
22 Canal. The purchase and installation of these permanent generators
23 will reduce and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result
24 of severe weather or other hazards. The City match requirements have
25 been met.

26 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
27 approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
28 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on
29 behalf of the City, the Modification to Subgrant Agreement, Contract
30 Number H0543, Modification Number Two, between the City of
31 Jacksonville and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency

1 Management, substantially in the attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and
2 incorporated herein by this reference.

3 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Department of Public Works,
4 Engineering and Construction Management Division shall oversee the
5 project described herein.

6 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2024-505-E, being the
7 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and
8 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to add
9 additional funding for the project entitled "Stormwater Pump Stations
10 Generators." The project is more fully described in the Project
11 Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and incorporated
12 herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this
13 amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will
14 be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
15 deferral will result in the City's loss of needed grant dollars.

16 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
17 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
18 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment
19 set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an
20 amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-
21 Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E
22 shall continue in full force and effect.

23 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
25 without the Mayor's signature.
