AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$500,000, ORIGINALLY 6 7 APPROVED THROUGH THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON PARKS 8 AND QUALITY OF LIFE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE 9 ATLANTIC BEACH GAIL BAKER COMMUNITY CENTER AND APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2023-348-E, TO PROVIDE 10 FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ATLANTIC BEACH 11 MARSH OAKS COMMUNITY CENTER (THE "MARSH OAKS 12 13 PROJECT"); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY 14 ΤO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY 15 OF 16 JACKSONVILLE AND THE CITY OF ATLANTIC BEACH RELATED TO THE MARSH OAKS PROJECT; AMENDING THE 17 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN 18 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO DELETE THE 19 20 PROJECT ENTITLED "PARKS QOL - BAKER CENTER 21 IMPROVEMENTS"; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE 22 PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 23

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, 27 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 28 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 29 listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

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The funding above represents an appropriation of \$500,000, originally approved through the Special Committee on Parks and Quality of Life for improvements to the Atlantic Beach Gail Baker Community Center and appropriated by Ordinance 2023-348-E, from the Authorized Capital Projects - FY23 and Forward Fund Long Term Debt Issued - Debt Management Fund Loan Proceeds account to the DM Subsidies and Contributions to Other Govt account, to provide funds for improvements to the Atlantic Beach Marsh Oaks Community Center project (the "Marsh Oaks Project").

Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in 16 Purpose. Section 1 is to provide funds for improvements to the City of Atlantic 17 Beach Marsh Oaks Community Center. The City originally approved a 18 contribution of \$500,000 through the Special Committee on Parks and 19 20 Quality of Life for expansion of the Atlantic Beach Gail Baker 21 Community Center to allow additional space for expanded programming 22 for children, adults and seniors. Since that time the City of Atlantic 23 Beach has secured partnership agreements with local non-profits to 24 provide expanded programming at the Gail Baker Community Center. In 25 an effort to further expand its opportunities to provide quality 26 programming and services to residents of Atlantic Beach and Duval 27 County, the City of Atlantic Beach has identified a site for a new 28 community center to be known as the "Marsh Oaks Community Center" which will be located at 100 W. First Street. This site once housed 29 a nursing home, and the facility will be renovated to meet the City 30 of Atlantic Beach's needs for the area. 31

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Approval and Authorization. The Mayor, or her 1 Section 3. 2 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to 3 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with the City of Atlantic Beach, Florida, providing the scope, terms and 4 5 conditions for the City of Jacksonville's reimbursement of qualified costs and expenses for the Marsh Oaks Project in an amount 6 7 not-to-exceed \$500,000, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and 8 9 to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by 10 the General Counsel, or his designee, and the City's Risk Management 11 Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements 12 in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code. 13

14 Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 15 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is 16 hereby amended to delete the project entitled "Parks QOL - Baker 17 Center Improvements" (the "Baker Project") as reflected in the Project 18 19 Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein 20 by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this 21 amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will 22 be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 23 deferral will unnecessarily delay reallocation of the funds from the 24 Baker Project to the Marsh Oaks Project as requested by the City of 25 Atlantic Beach and authorized herein.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this Section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E

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1 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

2 Section 5. Oversight. The Parks, Recreation and Community 3 Services Department shall have oversight over the agreement between 4 the City of Jacksonville and the City of Atlantic Beach for the Marsh 5 Oaks Project as authorized herein.

6 Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 7 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 8 without the Mayor's signature.
