6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$82,850.00 (A
7 \$25,000.00 GRANT FROM THE CHRISTOPHER & DANA
8 REEVE FOUNDATION AND \$57,850.00 FROM THE ADA
9 FUNDS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION
10 AND COMMUNITY SERVICES) FOR AN ADAPTIVE KAYAK
11 LAUNCH AT BETHESDA PARK, AS INITIATED BY
12 REVISED B.T. 19-111; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER
13 OF FUNDS FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL COMPLETION OF
14 THE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
15 DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE
16 AND DELIVER THE GRANT AWARD LETTER FROM THE
17 CHRISTOPHER & DANA REEVE FOUNDATION; AMENDING
18 THE 2019-2023 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
19 PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2018-505-E TO
20 DECREASE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "ADA
21 COMPLIANCE WITHIN PARKS/UPGRADE PARK";
22 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
23 PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES;
24 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,
27 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
28 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
29 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

1 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 19-111, September 16, 2019 -
2 NCSPHS and incorporated herein by this reference):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

8 The funding above is a grant in the amount of \$25,000.00
9 from the Christopher and Dana Reeve Foundation and a City
10 match of \$57,850.00 from the ADA funds of the Department
11 of Parks, Recreation and Community Services for an
12 adaptive kayak launch at Bethesda Park. The grant period
13 runs from June 1, 2019, through May 31, 2020.

14 **Section 2. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in
15 Section 1 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover
16 from year to year until completion of the project.

17 **Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
18 Section 1 is to install an adaptive kayak launch at Bethesda Park.
19 The proposed adaptive launching system includes a unique gangway
20 with kayak chute connected to a floating dock with kayak cradle,
21 transition seat, grab bars, and straps to assist the launching of
22 kayaks for people of a wide variety of abilities. In addition, the
23 project will include improvements and expansion of the existing
24 sidewalk, to which the launch system will attach and connect to the
25 existing accessible parking area.

26 **Section 4. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
27 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
28 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Grant
29 Award Letter from the Christopher & Dana Reeve Foundation, attached
30 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

31 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2018-505-E, being

1 the 2019-2023 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
2 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
3 decrease funding for the project entitled "ADA Compliance within
4 Parks/Upgrade Park." The project is more fully described in the
5 Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 3**,
6 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Revised CIP, September 16, 2019 -
7 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council
8 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next
9 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best
10 interests of the community because such deferral will result in an
11 unnecessary delay in the construction of this recreational
12 infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,
13 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-
14 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the
15 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall
16 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2018-505-E. In all other
17 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by
18 Ordinance 2018-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

19 **Section 6. Oversight.** The Department of Parks,
20 Recreation and Community Services shall oversee the project
21 described herein.

22 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
24 without the Mayor's signature.
