AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ORDINANCE 2024-634-E TO ADDRESS REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 121.104 (REVIEW OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION), PART 1 (POLICE AND FIRE PENSION FUND ADMINISTRATION), CHAPTER 121 (POLICE AND FIREFIGHTERS PENSION ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING DIRECTION TO THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION; PROVIDING FOR RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2024, the City Council approved Ordinance 2024-634-E, which included a change to section 121.105 (Pensioner's rights upon reemployment by City); and

WHEREAS, per section 121.104 (Review of proposed legislation), Ordinance 2024-634-E was supposed to have been presented to the Board of Trustees, Police and Fire Pension Fund for review and comment; and WHEREAS, additionally, an actuarial report together with recommendations and comments from the State Division of Retirement

WHEREAS, an actuarial analysis, attached as Exhibit 1, has since been performed and it was determined that Ordinance 2024-634-E "will not have an actuarial impact on the Fund for advance funding purposes"; and
