4 **ORDINANCE 2025-222**

5 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ORDINANCE 2024-634-E TO
6 ADDRESS REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 121.104 (REVIEW
7 OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION), PART 1 (POLICE AND
8 FIRE PENSION FUND ADMINISTRATION), CHAPTER 121
9 (POLICE AND FIREFIGHTERS PENSION PLAN),
10 *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING DIRECTION TO THE
11 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION; PROVIDING FOR
12 RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING AN
13 EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, on September 10, 2024, the City Council approved
16 Ordinance 2024-634-E, which included a change to section 121.105
17 (Pensioner's rights upon reemployment by City); and

18 **WHEREAS**, per section 121.104 (Review of proposed legislation),
19 Ordinance 2024-634-E was supposed to have been presented to the Board
20 of Trustees, Police and Fire Pension Fund for review and comment; and

21 **WHEREAS**, additionally, an actuarial report together with
22 recommendations and comments from the State Division of Retirement
23 was to have accompanied Ordinance 2024-634-E; and

24 **WHEREAS**, an actuarial analysis, attached as **Exhibit 1**, has since
25 been performed and it was determined that Ordinance 2024-634-E "will
26 not have an actuarial impact on the Fund for advance funding
27 purposes"; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2024-634-E and the analysis have been
29 provided to the State Division of Retirement; and

30 **WHEREAS**, as part of the consideration of this ordinance, the
31 Council has sought the review and comment of the Board of Trustees,

1 Police and Fire Pension Fund on the changes enacted per Ordinance
2 2024-634-E; and

3 **WHEREAS**, it is the will of the Council to comply with the
4 requirements of section 121.104, *Ordinance Code*, now, therefore

5 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1. Directing Legislative Services to Place This**
7 **Ordinance to the File for Ordinance 2024-634-E.** The Legislative
8 Services Division is directed to place this ordinance in the file for
9 Ordinance 2024-834-E.

10 **Section 2. Retroactive Applicability and Findings.** This
11 ordinance shall be retroactive in application so that the requirements
12 set forth in section 121.104 are satisfied in the enactment of
13 Ordinance 2024-634-E.

14 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming law without
16 the Mayor's signature.
