RESOLUTION 2025-478

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF MONE HOLDER, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION, REPRESENTING PLANNING DISTRICT 5, PURSUANT TO SECTION 30.201 (ESTABLISHMENT; MEMBERSHIP), PART 2 (PLANNING COMMISSION), CHAPTER 30 (PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT), *ORDINANCE CODE*, REPLACING ANTOINETTE "TINA" MESKEL, FOR A PARTIAL TERM TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, FOLLOWED BY A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2028; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Moné Holder was appointed to the Planning Commission representing Duval County at-large pursuant to Resolution 2023-641-A; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires that Ms. Holder vacate her at-large seat on the Planning Commission in order to fill the open seat for Planning District 5 Planning Commission Representative; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The Council hereby confirms the appointment of Moné Holder, a Duval County resident, to the Planning Commission, representing Planning District 5, pursuant to Section 30.201 (Establishment; membership), Part 2 (Planning Commission), Chapter 30 (Planning and Development Department), *Ordinance Code*, replacing Antoinette "Tina" Meskel, for a partial term to expire on September 30, 2025, followed by a first full term to expire on September 30, 2028.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
