Funds will be used for contractual services to implement a hardware solution for Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Voting Act UOCAVA ballots returned whether due to damage or incorrect card stock. The funding does not require a match. While the total award agreement (#H98210-24-1-006)is for 60 months (July 14, 2024 through July 14, 2029) and a total of \$744,350, only \$148,870. (year 1 funding) has been made available for obligation. Supervisor of Elections staff will be responsible for ongoing performance and financial reporting throughout the grant period. There are no anticipated post-construction costs.
