5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$400,000.00 IN
6 GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
7 CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, AND APPROPRIATING
8 \$85,000.00 FROM KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE AS A
9 PARTIAL LOCAL MATCH, TO IMPLEMENT THE CRIMINAL
10 JUSTICE, MENTAL HEALTH, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE
11 REINVESTMENT GRANT PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") TO
12 INCREASE PUBLIC SAFETY AND IMPROVE THE
13 ACCESSIBILITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF TREATMENT
14 SERVICES FOR JUVENILES SUFFERING FROM MENTAL
15 ILLNESS, SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDERS, OR CO-
16 OCCURRING MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE
17 DISORDERS, AND WHO ARE IN, OR AT RISK OF
18 ENTERING, THE CRIMINAL OR JUVENILE JUSTICE
19 SYSTEMS, FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE THREE (3)
20 YEAR GRANT TERM BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH
21 JUNE 30, 2022, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 21-092;
22 AMENDING FIFTH REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE
23 2020-511-E; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION
24 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE CODE*, WITH RESPECT TO
25 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO
26 CHILD HEALTH, INC.; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
27 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE
28 CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF
29 EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE,
30 TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONTRACT WITH MANAGED
31 ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC. FOR THE PROVISION

1 OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY FOR LOCAL
2 IMPLEMENTATION AND EXPANSION OF THE PROGRAM;
3 WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(A)
4 (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE
5 ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE
6 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO
7 CHILD HEALTH, INC. FROM COMPETITIVE
8 PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
9 KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
10 DATE.

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12 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
14 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
15 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
16 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

23 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

24 The funding above comprises \$400,000.00 in grant funds
25 from the Florida Department of Children and Families and
26 an additional appropriation of \$85,000.00 from the Kids
27 Hope Alliance ("KHA"), for implementation of the Criminal
28 Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment
29 Grant Program.

30 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
31 Section 1 is to fund the first year of local implementation and

1 expansion of the Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance
2 Abuse Reinvestment Grant Program (the "Program") for the period
3 beginning July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. The overall grant
4 term is three (3) years beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30,
5 2024. A copy of the Florida Department of Children and Families
6 Criminal Justice, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Reinvestment
7 Grant Award Notice # DCF RFA 2021-001 is attached hereto as **Exhibit**
8 **2** and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the budget
9 schedule reflecting the intended sources and uses of funds for the
10 first year of the grant is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

11 **Section 3. Amending Fifth Revised Schedule M to Ordinance**
12 **2020-511-E.** There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2020-2021
13 budget for the Kids Hope Alliance by substituting in the place of
14 Fifth Revised Schedule M, approved by Ordinance 2020-511-E, the
15 Sixth Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and
16 incorporated herein by this reference. The Sixth Revised Schedule M
17 will reflect additional transfers and funds appropriated herein.

18 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**
19 **Ordinance Code.** KHA is hereby authorized to procure
20 professional services from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc.
21 ("MATCH") for local implementation and expansion of the Program in
22 compliance with the grant authorized in Section 1 above. Pursuant
23 to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations),
24 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such services are
25 exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be
26 provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to
27 this Ordinance.

28 **Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** The
29 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the
30 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute
31 and deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child
