9 OPERATIONS - OFFICE EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE  
10 FUNDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF SIX (6) COIN AND  
11 CURRENCY RECYCLING/VERIFICATION MACHINES, AS  
12 INITIATED BY B.T. 24-135; PROVIDING FOR  
13 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025;  
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

28 The funding above is an appropriation of funds from the  
29 Tax Collector Current and Delinquent Taxes - Tax Redemption  
30 Fees - Tax Sale account to the Tax Collector General  
31 Operations - Office Equipment account to provide funding

1 for the replacement of six (6) coin and currency  
2 recycling/verification machines at the Tax Collector  
3 facilities.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
5 Section 1 is to provide funding for the replacement of six (6) coin  
6 and currency recycling/verification machines used by the Duval County  
7 Tax Collector. The existing equipment has been used extensively on a  
8 daily basis for the past eight (8) years and needs replacement.

9 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this  
10 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-  
11 2025.

12 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
14 without the Mayor's signature.
