19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,

30 The funding above is an appropriation of \$13,500.00 in
31 Emergency Food and Shelter Program Phase 38 grant funds

1 from DHS/FEMA and distributed through United Way
2 Worldwide to be used to provide emergency mortgage, rent
3 and utility assistance to Duval County veterans (the
4 "EFSP Grant").

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to allocate EFSP Grant funds to the Military Affairs
7 and Veterans Department to be used for emergency mortgage, rent and
8 utility assistance for Duval County veterans in accordance with the
9 EFSP Phase 38 - Budget attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and
10 incorporated herein by this reference. These funds will be
11 utilized to supplement and extend existing resources available to
12 local veterans and will not be used to substitute or reimburse
13 ongoing programs and services. No City match is required.

14 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Military Affairs
15 and Veterans Department shall oversee administration of the EFSP
16 Grant.

17 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
19 without the Mayor's signature.
