**ORDINANCE 2025-428**

AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND  
APPROPRIATING \$1,015,020.00 FROM VARIOUS  
PROGRAMS PREVIOUSLY FUNDED BY ORDINANCES 2023-  
807-E AND 2023-847-E, WHICH INCLUDES \$150,000.00  
FROM RIVERFRONT PARKS, \$55,000.00 FROM LOCAL  
STACK FUNDING FOR ATTAINABLE HOUSING,  
\$110,000.00 FROM A CASH CARRYOVER ACCOUNT,  
\$100,000.00 FROM THE NON-PROFIT COMMUNITY OPEN  
HOUSE, \$200,000.00 FROM THE HOMELESS CONTINUUM  
OF CARE BONUS MATCH, \$136,752.50 FROM THE FILM  
AND TELEVISION OFFICE, AND \$263,267.50 FROM THE  
HOME ROOF INITIATIVE, TO PROVIDE GAP FUNDING  
THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, FOR TWO CONTRACTS  
IMPLEMENTING PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES APPROVED  
BY ORDINANCES 2023-807-E AND 2023-847-E,  
INCLUDING (1) \$205,020.00 TO TELESCOPE HEALTH,  
LLC FOR A TELEHEALTH SAFETY NET CLINIC, AND (2)  
\$810,000.00 TO URBAN JACKSONVILLE, INC. FOR AN  
ELDERLY FOOD INSECURITY PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY  
REVISED B.T. 25-100; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE.

**WHEREAS,** Ordinance 2023-807-E and Ordinance 2023-847-E  
appropriated funds to certain of the Mayor's programs and initiatives,

1 and the City entered into certain contracts to implement these  
2 programs and initiatives, including, (1) Contract between City of  
3 Jacksonville and Telescope Health, LLC for Telehealth Safety Net  
4 Clinic (City Contract No. 71335-24), and (2) Contract between City  
5 of Jacksonville and Urban Jacksonville, Inc. for Elderly Food  
6 Insecurity Program (City Contract No. 71338-24) (the "Contracts");  
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, because the respective terms of the Contracts do not  
9 align with the City's fiscal year, there is a gap in funding through  
10 September 30, 2025; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the City Council therefore desires to appropriate  
12 funds to cover this gap for the Contracts; now therefore

13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,  
15 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
16 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
17 listed in subsection (b):

25 The funding above represents an appropriation of  
26 \$1,015,020.00 from the following: General Fund Operating -  
27 Riverfront Parks Subsidies and Contributions to Private  
28 Organizations account (\$150,000.00), General Fund - Local  
29 Stack Funding for Attainable Housing Miscellaneous Grants  
30 and Aids account (\$55,000.00), General Fund - JXSF Citywide  
31 Cash Carryover account (\$110,000.00), Special Events -

General Fund - Non-Profit Community Open House  
Miscellaneous Services and Charges account (\$100,000.00),  
Homeless Initiatives Special Revenue Fund - Homeless  
Continuum of Care Bonus Match Miscellaneous Grants and Aids  
account (\$200,000.00), General Trust and Agency - Film and  
Television Office Trust Subsidies and Contributions to  
Private Organizations account (\$136,752.50), and General  
Trust and Agency - Home Roof Initiative Miscellaneous  
Grants and Aids account (\$263,267.50) to the General Fund  
(1) Telehealth Safety Net/Healthlink Jax - Other  
Professional Services account (\$205,020.00), and (2) the  
Food Insecurity Relief - Other Professional Services  
account (\$810,000.00).

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
Section 1 is to provide funding for each of the following City  
contracts: (1) \$205,020.00 to Telescope Health, LLC for a telehealth  
safety net clinic (City Contract No. 71335-24), and (2) \$810,000.00  
to Urban Jacksonville, Inc. for an elderly food insecurity program  
(City Contract #71338-24) to cover a gap in funding through September  
30, 2025.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
without the Mayor's signature.
