AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$148,870.00, IN GRANT FUNDING AWARDED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, DEFENSE HUMAN RESOURCES ACTIVITY, TO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") THROUGH THE FEDERAL VOTING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING DUVAL COUNTY UNIFORMED AND OVERSEAS CITIZENS ABSENTEE VOTING ACT (UOCAVA) VOTER EXPERIENCE, FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF A FIVE YEAR GRANT TERM BEGINNING ON JULY 14, 2024 THROUGH JULY 14, 2029, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE 150; UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

 - Explanation of Appropriation The funding above represents

a grant from the U.S. Department of Defense, Defense Human Resources Activity, to the City of Jacksonville (the "City") through the Federal Voting Assistance Program, to improve the Duval County Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) voter experience through technologies that provide faster and more accurate ballot duplication. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to the City for a digital ballot duplication system to implement a hardware solution to duplicate returned UOCAVA ballots that are unreadable or on the incorrect stock, improving transparency and trust in the UOCAVA process. The funding will also reduce staff burden by using more efficient processes. A copy of the Grant Agreement Award (No. H98210-24-1-0006) has been placed On File with the Legislative Services Division (the "Agreement").

Section 3. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Supervisor of Elections is hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, the Agreement in substantially the form that has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division.

Section 4. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction.

Emergency passage upon introduction of this ordinance is requested to insure that the digital ballot duplication systems are purchased and in place prior to the November elections.

Section 5. Oversight. The Supervisor of Elections shall oversee the project and the grant described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
