Type of Action: Resolution approving the City of Jacksonville Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan revisions and designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill approves City of Jacksonville Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan revisions. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division will provide oversight.

Background Information: The State of Florida requires each county to submit a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan every four years for review. Local emergency management plans are designed to provide guidance and procedures relative to emergency preparedness and management and act as a mechanism that allows for standardization of policies to facilitate an integrated and coordinated response among local, state, and federal government and non-profit entities to protect against, prepare for, respond to, recover from, and mitigate the impacts of a wide variety of disasters. The revisions include: revised terminology, revised organizational chart, updated population and demographics, and updated evacuation zones and routes.
