5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$37,681.99 IN GRANT  
6 FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF  
7 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ("FDEP"), TO PROVIDE  
8 FUNDING FOR COMPLIANCE ACTIVITIES AT FACILITIES  
9 PERMITTED PURSUANT TO TITLE V OF THE CLEAN AIR  
10 ACT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 26-041; PROVIDING FOR  
11 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027;  
12 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF  
13 ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DEPARTMENT,  
14 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN  
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2025-2026 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

29 The appropriation above is a grant award from the State of  
30 Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for  
31 the purpose of, among other things, providing funding

1 assistance for the Title V activities performed by the City  
2 of Jacksonville's approved local air pollution control  
3 program. The grant period commenced on October 1, 2025  
4 and ends June 30, 2027. No local match is required.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
6 Section 1 is to provide funding assistance for the Title V activities  
7 performed by the City's approved local air pollution control program.  
8 The City will cooperate with FDEP for the monitoring of certain  
9 activities to evaluate and ensure compliance with the requirements  
10 of Title V of the Clean Air Act. A copy of the State of Florida  
11 Department of Environmental Protection Standard Grant Agreement,  
12 Agreement Number TV032, has been placed **On File** with the Legislative  
13 Services Division.

14 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this  
15 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2026-  
16 2027.

17 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Office of Administrative  
18 Services Department, Environmental Quality Division, shall oversee  
19 the grant and project described herein, including preparation and  
20 submittal of any reports required by the grant.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
23 without the Mayor's signature.
