("TRM") FOR THE 12 PROGRAM 13 TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR 14 CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; WAIVING 15 16 SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), 17 18 PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY 19 GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT 20 CONTRACT WITH TRM; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION 21 22 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF 23 JACKSONVILLE AND TRM FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING 24 25 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; 26 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 27

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,

10The funding above is an appropriation of \$114,272 from a11General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency account12to the General Fund Operating Subsidies and Contributions13to Private Org account to provide a grant to Trinity Rescue14Mission, Inc. ("TRM") for the Transportation Assistance15Program (the "Program") as described herein.

Section 2. **Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in 16 Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to 17 Trinity Rescue Mission, Inc. for the Transportation Assistance 18 Program as described in Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 19 20 2, Rev Term Sheet & Budget, March 17, 2025 - NCSPHS" attached hereto 21 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program was designed 22 to provide reliable transportation for homeless individuals in Duval County with the goal of assisting them in obtaining and sustaining 23 24 gainful employment and access to food. TRM intends to use the City funds to provide transportation for at least 50 residents of Duval 25 26 County to appointments, job interviews and/or places of employment, 27 and to assist them in acquiring a government-issued ID or driver's 28 license. The City funds will be used to pay the salaries for two 29 drivers and two coordinators for the Program, and the remaining portion will be used for various operational costs including vehicle 30 fuel and maintenance, vehicle insurance, and leasing of specialized 31

1 or supplementary equipment (e.g. software and communication devices).

2 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall 3 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. 4 The 5 provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 6 7 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with TRM. This waiver is justified because TRM 8 9 has a long-standing reputation for assisting Duval County's homeless 10 population in obtaining and retaining gainful employment. The Program provides a crucial service that lends itself to TRM's continued 11 12 in assisting one of Duval County's most vulnerable success 13 populations.

14 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is 15 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 16 17 the City a grant agreement with Trinity Rescue Mission, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$114,272, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget 18 19 more particularly described in **Revised Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, and all 20 21 other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and 22 amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to 23 24 appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for 25 26 appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code. 27

28 Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract 29 Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the 30 project described herein.

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Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become

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1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 2 without the Mayor's signature.
