WHEREAS, Part 2, Chapter 655, Ordinance Code, authorizes the cancellation or termination of development agreements, subject to the procedures and requirements set forth therein; and

20 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville City Council enacted Ordinance 21 2011-734-E in January 2012, which approved a development agreement 22 with First Coast Land Development Inc. ("FCLD") (Concurrency 23 Reservation Certificate No. 40796.1) known as "Firestone Road PUD" 24 consisting of approximately 1.64 acres located in Council District 25 10, on the east side of I-295, on Firestone Road, between Wilson Blvd. and Thurston Road (R.E. No. 012570-0000 and 012569-0000) in 26 27 order to reserve sufficient traffic circulation capacity for 17,000 enclosed square feet of shopping center uses (ITE Code 820) (the 28 29 "Development Agreement"); and

30 WHEREAS, on July 2, 2021, FCLD transferred ownership of all the 31 property subject to the Development Agreement to the City of Jacksonville for a fire station pursuant to Ordinance 2021-176-E; and

WHEREAS, FCLD has requested that the Development Agreement be terminated by the City of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has recommended
approval of the Termination of Development Agreement between the City
of Jacksonville and FCLD; and

7 WHEREAS, the required Planning and Development Department 8 informative workshop was held and the required public hearings were 9 held by the Transportation, Energy and Utilities Committee and the 10 City Council, all with public notice provided, pursuant to Section 11 655.205, Ordinance Code; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 Section 1. Approval of Termination of Development Agreement. The Termination of Development Agreement between the City 14 of Jacksonville and FCLD, is hereby approved in substantially the 15 same form as Exhibit 1, attached hereto. The Mayor and Corporation 16 Secretary are authorized to execute said Termination of Development 17 Agreement on behalf of the City. 18

19 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 20 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 21 without the Mayor's Signature.
