AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$90,000.00 FROM THE LOBLOLLY WETLANDS MITIGATION FUND ACCOUNT TO THE PALMETTO LEAVES REGIONAL PARK - BOARDWALK AND NATURE TRAIL ACCOUNT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 500 LINEAR FEET OF WOODEN BOARDWALK AT THE PALMETTO LEAVES REGIONAL PARK, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 19-082; AMENDING THE 2019-2023 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2018-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "PALMETTO LEAVES REGIONAL PARK - BOARDWALK AND NATURE TRAIL"; PROVIDING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL BOARDWALK CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2018-2019 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(C) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a transfer from the Loblolly Wetlands Mitigation Fund account to the Palmetto Leaves Regional Park - Boardwalk and Nature Trail account for the construction of 500 linear feet of wooden boardwalk at the Palmetto Leaves Regional Park in accordance with Section 111.780 (Loblolly Wetlands Mitigation Special Revenue Fund), Ordinance Code.

Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover from year to year until boardwalk construction is completed.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for the construction of 500 linear feet of boardwalk at the Palmetto Leaves Regional Park.

Section 4. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2018-505-E, being the 2019-2023 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Palmetto Leaves Regional Park - Boardwalk and Nature Trail." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will create an unnecessary delay in the construction of this recreational infrastructure, which once constructed will satisfy outstanding Florida Community Trust (FCT) obligations. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-
