5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$275,000.00 FROM THE
6 SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND")
7 FOR DONATIONS TO NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC.,
8 BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA (\$10,000.00), THE PARENT
9 HELP CENTER, INC. (\$20,000.00), FIRST COAST
10 CRIME STOPPERS, INC. (\$23,000.00), FLORIDA CRIME
11 PREVENTION ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED
12 (\$1,000.00), AND THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
13 MEMORIAL AND MUSEUM (\$1,000.00), IN ACCORDANCE
14 WITH SECTION 932.7055(5), FLORIDA STATUTES, TO
15 SUPPORT DRUG TREATMENT, DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION,
16 DRUG PREVENTION, CRIME PREVENTION, SAFE
17 NEIGHBORHOODS, AND SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER
18 PROGRAM(S), TRANSFERRING \$12,500.00 FROM THE
19 FUND TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR
20 THE TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM, IN ACCORDANCE
21 WITH SECTION 111.365, *ORDINANCE CODE*,
22 TRANSFERRING \$7,500.00 FROM THE FUND TO THE
23 POLICE EXPLORERS TRUST FUND FOR THE JACKSONVILLE
24 SHERIFF'S POLICE EXPLORER POST, AND
25 APPROPRIATING \$200,000.00 TO PROCURE AND INSTALL
26 SECURITY FENCING AT VARIOUS JACKSONVILLE
27 SHERIFF'S OFFICE FACILITIES; PURPOSE OF
28 APPROPRIATION; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
29 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
30 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF
31 THE CITY, MISCELLANEOUS APPROPRIATIONS

1 AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND
2 NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC., BOY SCOUTS OF
3 AMERICA, THE PARENT HELP CENTER, INC., AND FIRST
4 COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC.; PROVIDING FOR CITY
5 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE;
6 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

9 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
10 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
11 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
12 listed in subsection (b):

14 this reference)

19 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

20 The funding above represents an appropriation of
21 \$275,000.00 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund
22 for donations to various organizations as set forth herein
23 to support drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug
24 prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or
25 school resource officers programs administered by various
26 agencies in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida
27 Statutes. In addition, the funding above includes a
28 transfer of \$12,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver
29 Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program
30 in accordance with Section 111.365, *Ordinance Code*, and a
31 transfer of \$7,500.00 from the Fund to the Police Explorers

1 Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police
2 Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340,
3 *Ordinance Code*. This funding also includes an
4 appropriation of \$200,000.00 to purchase and install
5 security fencing at various Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
6 facilities.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to provide donations to the following organizations, in
9 the stated amounts: North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America
10 (\$10,000.00), The Parent Help Center, Inc. (\$20,000.00), First Coast
11 Crime Stoppers, Inc. (\$23,000.00), Florida Crime Prevention
12 Association Incorporated (\$1,000.00), and the National Law
13 Enforcement Memorial and Museum (\$1,000.00). This allocation
14 supports drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime
15 prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer
16 programs for the citizens of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County,
17 Florida. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that
18 the subject appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund
19 complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto
20 as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

21 In addition to the above, this appropriation includes a transfer
22 of \$12,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund
23 for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section
24 111.365, *Ordinance Code*, as well as a transfer of \$7,500.00 from the
25 Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's
26 Office Police Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340,
27 *Ordinance Code*, and an appropriation of \$200,000.00 for the purchase
28 and installation of security fencing for various Jacksonville
29 Sheriff's Office facilities.

30 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby
31 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation

1 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
2 the City, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City
3 of Jacksonville and North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of
4 America, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City
5 of Jacksonville and The Parent Help Center, Inc., and the
6 Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of
7 Jacksonville and First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. in substantially
8 the same forms as have been placed **On File** with the Office of
9 Legislative Services.

10 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
11 shall oversee the projects described herein.

12 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
