AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF SHANTEL N. DAVIS, A ST. JOHNS COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE HOMELESSNESS INITIATIVES COMMISSION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 86.103 (COMPOSITION; LIAISONS; TERMS; REMOVAL), 86 (HOMELESSNESS CHAPTER INITIATIVES COMMISSION), ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE ON FEBRUARY 28, ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL BUSINESS PHILANTHROPIC INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102(B) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; WAIVING SECTION 50.102(C) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS COMMISSIONS), ORDINANCE CODE, AS TO REQUIREMENT THAT THE BILL SPONSOR APPEAR BEFORE THE RULES COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THE APPEARANCE OF THE APPOINTEE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the work of the Homelessness Initiatives Commission (the "Commission") will begin imminently and requires the attention and input of members; and

WHEREAS, Commission members are needed to complete member training, fill vacancies, appoint officers and begin providing their

expertise as expeditiously as possible; now therefore

Section 1. Appointment. The City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Shantel N. Davis, a St. Johns County resident, to the Homelessness Initiatives Commission, pursuant to Section 86.103 (Composition; Liaisons; Terms; Removal), Chapter 86 (Homelessness Initiatives Commission), Ordinance Code, for a first full term ending February 28, 2027.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 2. Establishing Substantial Business or Philanthropic Interest in Duval County. Section 50.102(b) (Members of boards and commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either permanent residents of Duval County or to maintain substantial economic business or philanthropic interest as determined by the City Council within Duval County. In this instance, although the appointee does not reside within Duval County, Ms. Davis currently serves in leadership roles for several non-profit and philanthropic organizations based in and serving Duval County, including serving as a board member for the following organizations: Jacksonville University Public Policy, Jacksonville Classical Academy, YMCA Metro, Goodwill of Northeast Florida, and the University of North Florida Foundation.

Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 (Requesting Emergency Passage). One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the Commission requires appointees as soon as possible to begin addressing the significant issues presented by Duval County's homeless and chronically unhoused populations.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 50.102(c), Ordinance Code.

Section 50.102(c) (Members of boards and commissions), Part 1

(Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions),

Ordinance Code, is hereby waived as to the requirement that the bill sponsor appear before the Rules Committee prior to the appearance of the appointee. Because this legislation was filed requesting emergency passage by the Council, there was not sufficient time during the legislative process for the bill sponsor to appear prior to the appointee.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
