A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING MARK VANLOH AS A MEMBER OF THE DUVAL COUNTY TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, AS A COMMERCIAL AIRLINE INDUSTRY/JACKSONVILLE AVIATION AUTHORITY REPRESENTATIVE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 70.102 (A) (5), *ORDINANCE CODE*, AND SECTION 125.0104 (4) (E), *FLORIDA STATUTES*, FOR A SECOND FULL TERM EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2028; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Reappointment. The Council hereby reappoints Mark VanLoh, a Duval County resident, to the Duval County Tourist Development Council, as a commercial airline industry/Jacksonville Aviation Authority representative, in accordance with Section 70.102(A)(5), *Ordinance Code*, and Section 125.0104 (4)(e), *Florida Statutes*, for a second full term expiring June 30, 2028.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
