11 30, 2028; PROVIDING FOR A DIRECTIVE TO THE CHIEF
12 OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

15 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council hereby appoints Tyler
17 G. Grant, a Duval County resident, to the Jacksonville Housing Finance
18 Authority, in accordance with Chapter 52, *Ordinance Code*, as a
19 commerce representative, replacing Delilah R. "Dee" Bumbarger, for a
20 first full term expiring June 30, 2028.

21 **Section 2. Directive to the Chief of Legislative Services.**
22 Pursuant to Section 52.106(1), *Ordinance Code*, a certified copy of
23 the appointment or reappointment of any member to the Jacksonville
24 Housing Finance Authority shall, upon adoption, be filed with the
25 Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County, and the certificate shall
26 be conclusive evidence of the due and proper appointment or
27 reappointment of the member. The Chief of Legislative Services is
28 hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this appointment to
29 the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Duval County and the Jacksonville
30 Housing Finance Authority.

31 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
