9 ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO REQUIRE PRIOR CITY
10 COUNCIL APPROVAL FOR EXPENDITURES IN EXCESS OF
11 \$100,000 FROM THE HOMELESSNESS INITIATIVES
12 SPECIAL REVENUE FUND; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION
13 INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Amending Section 111.920 (Homelessness**
17 **Initiatives Special Revenue Fund), Part 9 (Neighborhood Development),**
18 **Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*.**
19 Section 111.920 (Homelessness Initiatives Special Revenue Fund), Part
20 9 (Neighborhood Development), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust
21 Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 **CHAPTER 111 - SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS**

24 **PART 9. - NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT**

26 **Sec. 111.920. - Homelessness Initiatives Special Revenue Fund.**

27 (a) *Special Revenue Fund Created.* There is hereby created the
28 *Homelessness Initiatives Special Revenue Fund* (the "Fund"), into
29 which all gifts, donations, contributions, grants, state and
30 federal funding, and other funding received by the City for
31 programs, initiatives, or services for Duval County's homeless

1 or chronically unhoused populations, with the exception of
2 funding received, from any source, for the Homelessness
3 Diversion Special Revenue Fund outlined in Section 111.270, or
4 for a specific identified program, initiative, or service, shall
5 be deposited. All sums placed into the Fund, which shall include
6 all program income and interest earned or accrued thereon, shall
7 not lapse at the close of any fiscal year but instead shall
8 carry over to the next fiscal year. Subject to appropriation by
9 the Council, the Director of Finance ~~and Administration~~, or his
10 or her designee, is authorized and directed to make
11 disbursements from the Fund upon the written request of the
12 Director of the Department charged with overseeing the
13 homelessness initiative for which funding is sought to provide
14 assistance with neighborhood and Citywide initiatives to address
15 homelessness and chronic homelessness; provided, however, any
16 single expenditure from the Fund in excess of \$100,000 shall
17 require prior Council approval.

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19 **Section 2. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the
20 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and
21 division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth
22 herein. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to
23 make the *Ordinance Code* consistent with the intent of this legislation
24 are approved and directed herein, and the changes to the *Ordinance*
25 *Code* shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

26 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
